



PROTECT YOURSELF FROM FRAUD

Here are some **RED FLAGS** you should be aware of in potential scam scenarios. 



Gift Card Requests

If you're asked to buy gift cards as part of an investigation, it's likely a scam. Legitimate authorities will never ask for payments in gift cards.



Cash Withdrawal Instructions

If someone advises you on what to say to the credit union when withdrawing large amounts of cash, be cautious. Legitimate transactions shouldn't require specific instructions.



Phishing Scams

Stay vigilant against suspicious emails or messages pretending to be from CFCU. Avoid clicking on unfamiliar links and CFCU will never ask you for your personal or login information.



Loan and Lottery Scams

Beware of requests to send money when depositing checks into your account. Exercise caution regarding fees labeled as 'taxes,' 'shipping,' or 'processing' to claim prizes, as these could potentially be scam attempts.

If you believe you are a victim of fraud, report it to your local authorities and inform Century Federal Credit Union immediately.
