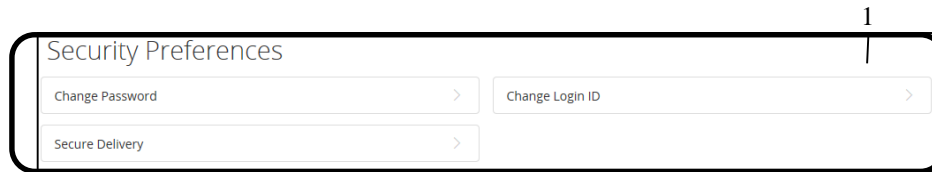


Security Preferences
